LIVING & WORKING AT EL QUESTRO

El Questro Wilderness Park is without doubt, one of the world's unique holiday destinations.

A million acres in size, El Questro is located on the eastern perimeter of the Kimberley region, and extends for approximately 80 kilometres into the Kimberley region in far North Western Australia is one of the world's last unspoilt frontiers - an ancient land extending from Broome in the South West to Kununurra and Wyndham near the Northern Territory border

GETTING THERE

El Questro is located in the east Kimberley region of Western Australia, approximately 110km from Kununurra which is just inside the Western Australia and Northern Territory border. The easiest way to get to El Questro if you do not have your own vehicle is by plane. Air North flights leave from Broome and Darwin daily to Kununurra. There is also a direct flight from Perth to Kununurra during the dry season. An El Questro representative will meet you from your flight and transfer you to El Questro. If driving you will need to go to Kununurra and onward to El Questro 110km away. 4wd is the only advisable vehicle due to unsealed dirt roads.

CLIMATE

El Questro is strongly affected by the tropical wet season and therefore only opens from April to November each year.

April until June and September to October are the hottest and most humid months with temperatures reaching 40°C, June through August are much milder averaging 27°C during the day, with cool nights.

OUR GUESTS

El Questro attracts a wide variety of guests and budgets due to the four different styles of accommodation available. With a mostly Australian clientele, El Questro still has a large international market especially in the camping sector.

PEAK SEASON

Peak occupancy periods are the winter months, when the weather is coolest and dry.

WORKING

There are almost 100 employees at El Questro who all live at the resort. The most common opportunities are in Housekeeping, Kitchen, Food and Beverage and Maintenance. At the end of the season staff may have the opportunity to move to other Delaware North venues, with vacant positions advertised internally. Cross training programs are available to encourage personal development.

There is commitment to the ongoing development and training of employees with many taking advantage of accredited programs.

All staff meals are supplied.

LIVING

There are several types of staff accommodation provided.

Rooms are simply furnished and air conditioned with shared bathroom facilities.

Most accommodation is on a single basis, although a small number of double accommodation rooms may be possible, based on availability.

Employees are encouraged to bring personal items, although rooms are small and basic with minimal storage space. Some staff bring portable stereos or a small TV for their room.

There is no mobile phone coverage, however, a public phone is available, and mobile coverage exists in Kununurra.

FREE TIME

All staff receive free of charge tours at El Questro and are encouraged to take full advantage to gain understanding of the property. Employees also receive discounts on helicopter flights.

Resort facilities include swimming hole at The Station & swimming pool at Emma Gorge, tennis court, crew room, gym, various dining options

The unique outback environment is a drawcard for many staff. Birdwatching and learning about the traditional

history of the land is an interest of some.

Camping, hiking and 4WD driving are popular with many of our team, as a great way to enjoy the spectacular Cockburn ranges and their surrounds.

There is an active wellbeing club which arranges a variety of events and activities.

Employees can take advantage of accommodation discounts at other Delaware North properties (after a qualifying period).
