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SUGGESTED ITINERARY

FIVE NIGHTS: SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE

DAY ONE:

12.00pm-4.00pm: Emma Gorge

Emma Gorge is one of the best known and spectacular gorges of the Kimberley. Enjoy a one hour walk and be rewarded at the end with a large cooling waterhole know as one of Australia's best swimming spots. Set at the base of towering 65m cliffs, the waterhole is graced by a droplet waterfall and a small thermal water outlet, which trickles down from the surrounding rocks.

DAY TWO:

8.00am-11.30am: Bush Skills and Culture Tour

Learn from our own real characters about the pioneers and previous characters of the original cattle station and the remarkable journey to acclaimed tourism destination. Take in the views from up high on a lookout, visit ancient Boab trees, learn about the Aboriginal peoples' use of the native flora and count the types of wildlife and plants you spot along the way. A light morning tea is served beside a lazy waterhole.

From 3.00pm: Chamberlain Cruise

Boating the Chamberlain Gorge is a must. Only accessible by boat, this 3 km fresh waterhole is bound by diverse flora and fauna, and belittled by a towering escarpment. Enjoy sparkling wine, soft drinks and fresh fruit as you take in the breathtaking scenery. Ask your Ranger about the cheeky Archerfish and Barramundi you can feed.

DAY THREE:

7.00am-11.00am: Zebedee Springs

This natural oasis is a short walk along a trail, which leads you through dense livistonia palms to a series of rocky thermal pools. Set at the base of sheer cliffs these thermal springs are the perfect place to relax and restore amongst the region's local vegetation. It's worth noting that Zebedee Springs is closed in the afternoon so plan your morning around a visit to the Springs so you don't miss out on this most popular of attractions.

2.30pm-5.00pm: Horse Riding

Horse treks are a great way to sneak up on all types of Kimberley wildlife and see the country from a new vantage point. Small groups are guided on a two hour afternoon trek along hidden trails.

DAY FOUR:

8am-11 am: Moonshine Waterhole

Follow this circular trail around Moonshine Creek where, for the first half of the hike, tall Livistona palms and towering cliff faces. With plenty of areas to rest and cool off with a swim it is worth noting that the second part of the walk is more exposed to the elements. The circuit finishes back at the car park.

12pm-2pm: Picnic at Jackaroos Waterhole

Set up a picnic under a shady tree by the clear waterhole to enjoy a leisurely lunch amongst the peaceful nature and have a splash in the refreshing water.

4pm-6pm: Saddleback Lookout at Sunset Tour

Chasing the best sunset when there are so many lookouts at El Questro can feel like a mammoth task but with this tour you get to experience the "best" of all of them. The drive to the top of Saddleback Ridge is steep and winding, which only allows for better views, and under the guide of an experienced Ranger you'll reach your destination where you'll enjoy drinks and a cheese platter while taking in the stunning 360-degree sunset view.

DAY FIVE:

From 5am: Guided Barramundi 4WD Fishing Tour

Head out on a 4WD fishing adventure with one of our fishing guides and with a little local knowledge you can try your hand at catching Barramundi or even a Mangrove Jack, Threadfin Salmon, Black Bream or Catfish. You don't need to be an expert to jump on this tour. All fishing gear, lunch, snacks and drinks are provided.
